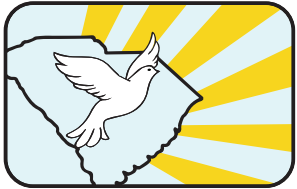

Deadline for a complete refund if cancellation is necessary is March 1, 2019. After this day, cancellation penalties are in effect as set by the tour operators and are outside of the control of the Council.
